## FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW TO APPLY FOR THE ECCE PROGRAM

- 1. Dual credit sponsorship signed by the school principal or counsellor:
- 2. Apply to Selkirk College through Education Planner BC: <a href="https://apply.educationplannerbc.ca/">https://apply.educationplannerbc.ca/</a>
- 3. Fill out the Program Admission Package (will receive after application)
- 4. The release of information from the college to the school (will receive with program application package)
- 5. Submit an electronic transcript: student transcript services
- 6. Acknowledgement/permission by parent or guardian with signature on the next page.



## YOU SAVE MONEY AND TIME. A REAL HEADSTART TO A CAREER.

- 1. The program is a cluster of three (3) courses. Successful completion of them generates twelve (12) Grade 12 credits as part of your graduation plan and transcript.
- 2. Successful completion of these three courses also results in the following:
  - Successful participants of the program will be immediately qualified to apply to the BC ECE Registry to work as ECE Assistants.
  - Once working, students can build onto the 9 credits in the Human Services academic stream to specialize and pursue full certification in Early Childhood Education, Infant Toddler or Inclusive Practices Educator or Child and Youth Care Worker. To continue beyond the dual credit semester, you must apply to the full program and meet all admission criteria.
- 3. The program, being dual credit, also results in the start of your post-secondary transcript. Failure or withdrawal would thus become part of this post-secondary record.
- 4. Being a post-secondary program, successful applicants are considered Selkirk College students with all the privileges and responsibilities associated with this.
- 5. ENGLISH STUDIES 12 can be taken concurrently with the ECCE dual credit courses if the student has a C+ grade in one of the ENGL 11 courses and with a written recommendation from the high school counsellor. Students who have already taken ENST12 or ENFP12 with C final grade, and an ENGL 11 grade of C+ are eligible for admission with written recommendation from the high school counsellor.
- 6. Tuition will be paid by your School District.
- 7. Purchasing the textbooks is required and will be paid by your school district
- 8. Parental and student acknowledgement can be signed below.
