HCAP – Paid HCA Training This is a position funded by Interior Health

The Health Career Access Program (HCAP) is a paid working and training position for individuals excited to start a career in healthcare. Hires may start in a Health Care Support Worker (HCSW) role providing non-direct care in long-term care, assisted living, home health or acute setting before completing paid training as a Health Care Assistant (HCA) at a participating post-secondary institution. After completing their training (which typically requires 6 to 12 months of full-time post secondary education), participants will return to their Interior Health work site to fulfill a 12-month Return of Service contract in exchange for the funding they received.
